Funded by private donations to the NSU Foundation, this unique program will provide annual awards of \$1,000 per semester for students to use toward their educational expenses.

To be eligible for the program, you must have completed 90 hours by the end of the spring semester, maintained a 3.25 grade point average, expect to attend NSU for two additional semesters, and anticipate earning their baccalaureate degree within the next three semesters. As a Rozell Scholar, you will represent the University and our student body at numerous social, civic and educational events throughout the year.
