SHOW A BIT OF CARE BY REPORTING STUDENT CONCERNS

Basic Needs:

Housing, difficulty managing stress, concern for eating disorders, food insecurity, changes in hygiene

Elevated Concerns:

Depression, hostility, violence, substance misuse, threats to self or others, stalking/harassment, sexual or physical assault



Academic Concerns:

Decline in attendance or grades, participation changes, missing or late assignments, academic misconduct, withdrawal from peer groups, disruptive behavior

Social Concerns:

Grief and loss, changes in mood or behavior, aggression, concerning social media posts
