### Admission Requirements

- » Undergraduate GPA of 2.5 overall, 2.75 GPA in last 60 hours of undergraduate, or entrance exam scores as designated in Graduate Catalog Student responsibility.
- » Official Transcripts.
- » Complete the appropriate entrance exam if required by the degree program.
- » Proof of citizenship for a U.S. citizen born outside of the United States and for a resident alien. An international applicant for whom English was the first language and is the spoken language in the home must sign a statement to that affect.
- » TOEFL (for international student, see International Student Graduate Application packet).

### TEACH Grant

The TEACH grant provides up to \$3,900 a year for two years to graduate students who are completing a NSU Master's degree in:

- » Reading Specialist
- » Science Education
- » Special Education - ASD
- » Mathematics Education

...and who agree to teach full time for at least four years, within eight years from degree completion, in a school serving low-income students in a high need field (Title I, school).

### Accelerated Degree Program
